Dear Mr. Riker:

I have reviewed the test report prepared by the Texas Transportation Institute for the Caminoverde, Inc. Shur-Tite sign support socket system.

The Shur-Tite system consists of a 17 inch long socket and six inch wedge both manufactured of high density polyethylene.

The test report indicates that the Shur-Tite Socket system, when used with 2 3/8 inch 13 BWG steel tubing or 2 3/8 inch Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic (FRP), meets the requirements of National Cooperative Highway Research Program Report 350 Crashworthiness Criteria.

When applied in accordance to manufacturer's directions, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) approves the use of this material to be used for the foundation of small sign supports where the total sign area does not exceed 10 square feet. Any modifications or misapplications of this product may result in TxDOT removing approval.
